### **Cooperation deal signed between EEAP and Bulgarian distributor SUNNY FILMS**

Berlin, September, 9th 2005

EEAP Eastern European Acquisition Pool GmbH signed a two-year distribution deal with Sunny Films. For the next two years, Bulgaria's second largest film distributor will release all of EEAP's titles theatrically and to home entertainment. The TV rights remain with EEAP.

The first titles under the deal include Alejandro Gonzalez Iñárritu's „Babel“, starring Cate Blanchett and Brat Pitt, Roger Donaldson's new film „The World's Fastest Indian“ with Sir Anthony Hopkins, which will premiere at Toronto International Film Fest, „Good Night, And Good Luck“, recently celebrated at Venice Film Fest with George Clooney acting and directing, and "Barefoot" by and with Til Schweiger.

"Bulgaria may not be the most important market in South-eastern Europe, but has gained after the second multiplex has opened in Sofia. Bulgaria's efforts to join the EU have had significant effect on curbing piracy in home entertainment and generating turnover. Sunny Films is a strong partner who has an excellent and long-lasting reputation with various studios," says EEAP's managing director Alexander van Dülmen.

EEAP Eastern European Acquisition Pool, established 2003, is a leading license trader in Central and Eastern Europe.

Sunny Films was founded 1992 and releases films by UIP and Buena Vista et al. Their market share in 2004 was 29% for theatrical, 53% for home entertainment.
