After 4 weeks since it's start, "Barefoot" ("Barfuss") is still running successfully in Russia

Berlin, October, 6th 2005

Til Schweiger's film "Barefoot" ("Barfuss"), which started in Russia with 35 prints on 1st September, is still running incredibly well after 4 weeks. Up till now, it has achieved 7.3 Mio Russian Rubel in the Box Office, (approx. 215,000 Euro). Gemini Film Intl, the leading distributor in Russia, still has 25 prints in circulation.

EEAP and A company have exploitation rights for the film "Barefoot" ("Barfuss") in all Central- and Eastern European countries. Early September the film will be brought into the cinema screens in Hungary, where up till now it has achieved a Box Office of HUF 10 million (ca. EUR 40.000).

The film will also be given a cinema release in the countries Poland, Rumania and Slovenia. In December, "Barefoot" ("Barfuss") will be shown at the Bratislava Film Festival, the capital city of Slovakia.

'We were able to sell the film to numerous television stations, and for the prime time programme', explains Alexander van Dülmen (Managing Director of eeap and CEO of A Company). "Barefoot" ("Barfuss") will be shown on the private Television stations TV2 in Hungary and on pay TV Canal+ in Poland. In Russia Channel ONE has acquired the TV rights and in the Baltics, TeleBaltics.
