## Willis to star in intense drama for Ziskin, Relativity

Bruce Willis will star in the drama *Morgan's Summit* for Laura Ziskin Productions and Relativity Media.

Relativity also arranged financing and partners Ryan Kavanaugh and Lynwood Spinks will serve as executive producers alongside producer Ziskin.

Arclight Films is handling international sales on the project, which is set to begin filming in Los Angeles next year.

*Dead Poets Society* screenwriter Tom Schulman is directing the story of an optimistic late-night radio host who turns vengeful after a brutal crime impacts on his life.

"Tom and I have wanted to work together since our collaboration on *What About Bob?*" Ziskin said. "When I read *Morgan's Summit*, I knew it rivaled *Dead Poet's Society* as a compelling, powerful and timely story with a tour de force role for an actor.
